






iPhone and iPad Post Automatic Install Configuration

These steps ensure that your sent and deleted emails are stored on the server and are available on other devices connected to your email account.

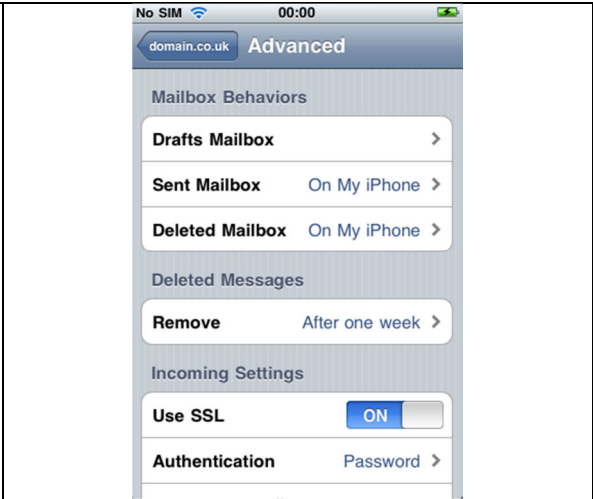
In turn, select

Sent Mailbox Sent >


and

Following the next two steps as appropriate.




Adjust the location of the Sent folder from the Device to the Sent folder on the Server.

Tap  to return to the previous screen

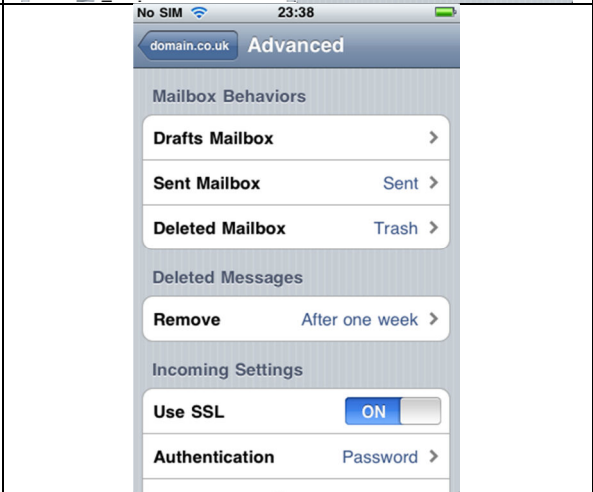




Adjust the location of the Deleted Mailbox from the Device to the Trash folder on the Server.
